Fire District Annual Budget:

The following assumptions were presented:

- 1) 5.9 % Cola and Merit Salary increase.
- 2) Expected inflation increase.
- 3) Continue funding frozen LOSAP.
- 4) Next payment on New Volunteer Benefit Plan.
- 5) Second of four payments into Volunteer Benefit Program for members not in LOSAP.
- 6) Workmen's Comp. and Insurance increases.
- 7) Health insurance increase (5%)
- 8) Fire Protection (water) rate increase
- 10) Grand List increase up 27% due to revaluation
- 11) Some improvement in interest on cash due to inflation.
- 12) Collection rate unchanged
- 13) Cellular increase to remain.

CAPITAL

- 14) Engine replacement schedule:
 - a. Engine 3 (24/25 timeframe)
 - b. Rescue 14 (25/26 timeframe)
 - c. Tanker 9 (26/27 timeframe)
 - d. Purchase of two FMO vehicles
- 15) Complete station camera upgrades, breathing equipment, Upgrade computer equipment, replace two imaging cameras, Firefighting Gear, HVAC replacement at Bushy Hill Station, Generator replacement at Bushy Hill and Tarriffville stations, HVAC and Heating at Tarriffville station, Fencing for security at Weatogue training grounds.

Generator replacement funds have been requested via the town as part of the Federal ARPA Funds.

The proposed budget if approved will carry a decrease in the Mill Rate.
